








I usually clean my house on Saturdays.

It is the regular routine of cleaning.



It was an exhaustive cleaning, more than the regular.

■ This month I haven't cleaned off the house, there are tons of things we have to remove.

This has to be a very deep cleaning to remove things.

Normal verbs use A PARTICLE to have a specific meaning







### ( Verbs can be separated

We can turn on the TV after lunch.

We can turn the TV on after lunch.

We can trun it on after lunch.



When using object pronouns, they can be only between the verb and the particle





## ( More examples

- I need to plug my telephone in the computer so that the files can be transferred.
- I need to plug in my telephone.
- I need to plug it in.
- We have to turn the radio down, they are studying.
- We have to turn down the radio.
- We have to turn it down.








■ I would like to know how to do my homework.

You don't know the process for doing your homework.

■ Do you know when to turn off the oven? I guess the cake is already baked.

You want to know the time to turn off the oven.

These aren't questions but sentences referring to questions







#### **Embedded questions or Question Word + verb?**

Do you know what time we have to arrive in their house?.

The question is indirectly embeded.

Do you know what time to arrive in their house? There is no question embedded, only an infinitive.





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
